Job Description:

Under supervision, provides persons, families or vulnerable populations with the psychosocial support needed to cope with chronic, acute or terminal illnesses and physical or developmental disabilities. Provides patient education and counseling, advises caregivers, and makes necessary referrals for other social services.

Job Responsibilities:

- Acts as client advocate to coordinate required services or to resolve crisis.
- Monitors, evaluates, and records client progress per measurable goals described in individualized family service plans (IFSP).
- Organizes support groups or counsel family members to assist them in understanding, dealing with, and supporting the client.
- Provides case management services related to identified treatment needs.
- Functions as Service Coordinator from point of referral.
- Facilitates and participates in the development of the IFSP.
- Coordinates implementing and ongoing management of services.
- Conducts periodic reviews of the IFSP per standards.
- Establish linkages and coordination of services with community agencies both public and private.
- Maintain up to date knowledge in field of Early Intervention.
- **Requires travel to families' homes within the 12 counties of District 4 Public Health (Butts, Carroll, Coweta, Fayette, Heard, Henry, Lamar, Meriwether, Pike, Spalding, Troup and Upson).**
- **Position will be based out of the District Office, 301 Main Street, LaGrange, GA 30240**

Minimum Qualifications: Master's degree in a related field from an accredited college or university AND eligibility to be licensed OR Bachelor's degree in a related field from an accredited college or university AND Two years of experience in social service delivery.

Preferred Qualifications: Home visiting experience AND experience working with children under 5 years of age **HIGHLY DESIRED**; Demonstrated experience with CIS Billing; Two years' experience providing case management; Experience in Part C (Early Intervention) or working with families and children with special needs and/or children with developmental delays.
