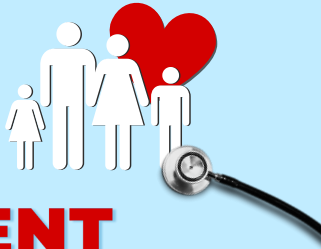

The Lamar County Health Department protects and improves the health of individuals and communities in our county by providing health care services, screenings, immunizations, and education for all ages.



We also help prevent disease and injury through our chronic disease prevention, WIC, environmental health, emergency preparedness, epidemiology programs. We are one of 12 county health department in District 4 of the Georgia Department of Health.

## DENTAL CLINIC

Our health department offers one of two Dental Clinics in District 4's 12-county region. Our dentist and dental hygienist provide quality, affordable dental exams, X-rays, cleanings, sealants, fillings, referrals and more. ## ALZHEIMER'S AND RELATED DEMENTIA DIAGNOSES

Through our partnership with [Georgia Memory Net](https://www.gamemorynet.org), individuals with memory concerns no longer need to travel outside Lamar County for a clinical diagnosis of Alzheimer's or related dementia. After receiving a primary doctor's referral, one can visit the Lamar County Health Department to be evaluated and diagnosed by a clinician during a telehealth visit. ### IMMUNIZATIONS

- Routine Immunizations for Adults and Children (including Form 3231: School Immunization Certificate)

- Blood Pressure Screenings

- Scoliosis

Offers nutrition and breastfeeding education, nutritious food benefits, and referrals to healthcare providers for eligible pregnant, breastfeeding or postpartum women, infants, and children to age 5.

### ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH

Inspects and monitors public and community factors that impact the health and safety of individuals and communities, including food service inspections, onsite sewage management, well water testing, lead poisoning prevention, tourist accommodation permits and inspections, and more.
